- Stay alert and scan the road ahead.
- Look for shining eyes at night.
- When you see one animal, watch for others.
- Obey posted speed limits. They usually indicate animal crossing areas.
- Pay special attention during dawn and dusk.

Between 1799 and 1875, five different fur trading posts existed along the banks of the North Saskatchewan River. The explorations that were carried out from Rocky Mountain House and others played a key role in determining the future shape of Canada.
