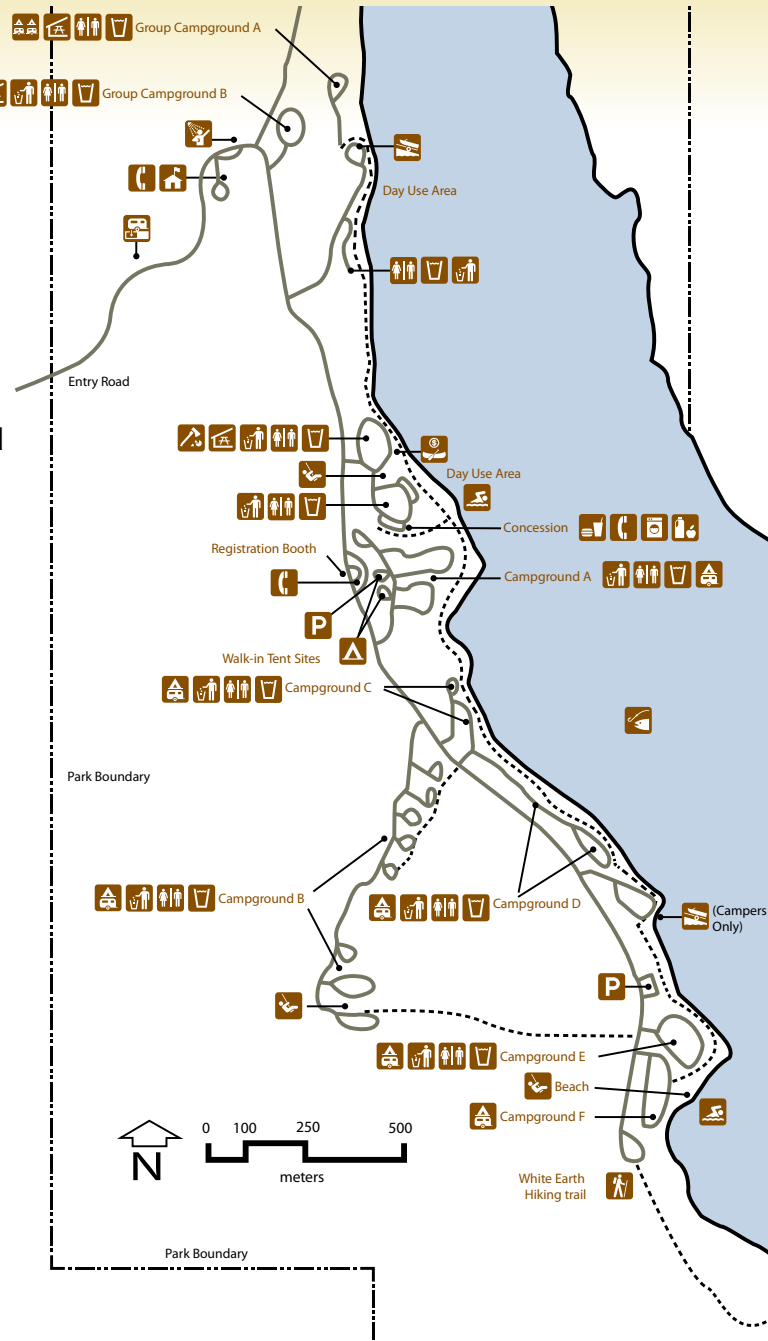


Long Lake Provincial Park Overview Map

Open year-round, Long Lake Provincial Park offers camping, boating, hiking and a sandy beach in summer. In winter there is access for cross-country skiing, ice fishing and other activities. This long, narrow lake surrounded by aspen, pine and spruce mixed forest is excellent habitat for songbirds and other wildlife. The park offers both sheltered and open sites to meet different campers' needs. Camping reservations are strongly recommended during summer months.

Modern conveniences include power sites, showers and flush toilets. A concession, laundry and grocery store are located in the day use area.

There is a boat rental, boat launch, dock, fish cleaning stand, playground and nearby golf course for family fun.
